Re: COVID-19 case at Rugby – Churchie Playing Fields

As we advised yesterday, a rugby player who played at Churchie on Saturday morning 31 July has been diagnosed with COVID-19. The game was between Brisbane Grammar School and Gregory Terrace. The person remained to watch the following game. My colleagues at the Metro North Public Health Unit are identifying and notifying contacts associated with the two games of interest.

The New Field at Churchie has been identified as a close contact area from 0730 to 1000, 31 July 2021. The remainder of your sporting fields are considered a low risk venue for that time period. This information will appear on the Queensland Health contact tracing website.

Anyone in your school community who was at New Field during the times outlined above should quarantine at their usual residence, get tested at their earliest opportunity and identify themselves as contact at www.health.qld.gov.au/tracing. Members of the school community not considered close contacts should get tested should they develop symptoms of concern.

The cooperation of Churchie in providing the times and locations of the rugby games is very much appreciated.
